

## TOWN OF ROCKPORT – TITLE 5 SUPPLEMENTS

September 27, 1977

Regulation adopted limiting validity of percolation/soil test for a period of two years.

October 22, 1985

Regulation adopted to extend the minimum distance requirements between a septic system including leaching area, septic tank or cesspool from 50-ft to 100-ft from the center line of all brooks, streams and rivers, and within 100-ft from the normal high water line of lakes, ponds, marshes, swamps, and brooks.

March 1, 1988

Regulation adopted allowing that extension of the two-year period of percolation/soil test validity would be taken under advisement upon written request being submitted to the Board of Health by the property owner.

December 8, 1988

Regulation adopted which requires each septic system to be located on the same lot as the dwelling/structure it serves. In addition, the lot boundaries must be marked with permanent boundary markers before the septic system is installed.

January 19, 1999

Regulation adopted that septage haulers must file a pumping report with the Rockport Board of Health within 30 days of pumping activity.
