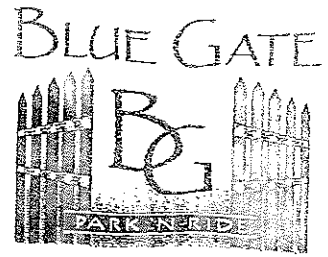


WELCOME TO ROCKPORT



On behalf of the **Town of Rockport and Cape Ann Transportation Authority**, we would like to welcome you to Rockport and hope you enjoy your visit.

The Cape Ann Transportation Authority operates both the Blue Gate Meadow Park 'n Ride and the shuttle service to downtown Rockport. Please note the following items while you are using the parking lot:

- The Parking Lot will be open Saturday, May 16th and Sunday, May 17th, and Memorial Day Weekend, May 23, 24, and 25. Beginning May 30, 2009, it will be open Saturdays and Sundays through June 28th, 2009, and open Monday June 29th and Tuesday June 30th, 2009. Effective Tuesday, July 1, 2009, through Monday, September 7th, 2009, the lot will be open seven days a week and then it will be open weekends only from September 12th through September 27th, 2009, and the Week-End of the Harvest Festival Saturday, October 17th and Sunday, October 18th. The hours of operation are from 11:00 AM to 7:00 PM. **NOTE: The trolley does not operate Monday through Friday between 2:30PM and 3:00PM.**
- All parking is Free. The lot has 199 parking spaces and 6 handicapped parking spaces.
- The Shuttle Fee is \$1.00 per person. For seniors, anyone 60 and over, handicapped, and Medicare card holders, the Shuttle is \$.50 per person. Children under 5 are free to ride. Drivers do not make change. Please make every effort to have the exact change ready when boarding the Trolley/Bus.
- The Trolley/Bus runs approximately every 20-25 minutes and will drop you off downtown in Dock Square. The drop off site is also the site you will use to return to the Parking Lot.
- The **last** Shuttle bus pickup is 6:40 PM, so please plan your schedule accordingly to return to the Parking Lot before the **Lot closes at 7:00 PM.**
- Restroom facilities are provided for visitors use. There is no eating, drinking, or smoking on the Trolley/Bus. Furthermore, no animals can be transported unless they are service animals (tagged such) or caged.
- Neither the Town of Rockport nor Cape Ann Transportation Authority is responsible for damage to your auto or its contents.
